## Service

- > Technical service: Pit 23
- › Mountain bike cleaning area
  - > EXPO area behind the pump track

Starting numbers / transponders: seat post numbers will be issued with the starting documents for all disciplines. The transponder is integrated into the number. Exception: 24h teams will get the transponder separately in a drinking bottle:

Rider meeting / team leader meeting 24h race: will take place on Saturday at 10 a.m. on stage (Expo) and is mandatory for at least one team member.

Accident black spots road bike: Fuchsröhre, Kallenhardt, Wehrseifen, Brünnchen

Accident black spots 24h mountain bike: Single Trail "Kramer"

Transition zones 24h race: changing of rider is possible and permitted in the Grand Prix track area everywhere and from (almost) every lot. Changing outside the GP track along the Nordschleife or the mountain bike terrain passages is forbidden.

Participant center: the PC is located in pits 18-21.

Opening hours are Friday 4 p.m. to 10 p.m. / Saturday 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. / Sunday 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Please come to the PC with sufficient time until your start!

## Catering

#### Food information

Aid stations for the participants will be located on the road bike course in the "Hohe Acht" section. Drinks will also be provided shortly after the "Bergwerk" section of the course. The 24h aid station for the mountain bike race is located in the area of "Graf-Ulrich-Halle".

#### Food-Corner

Food Corner is the name of our catering area in pits 28-33, where you will find a large selection of food and drinks almost around the clock, including a bread roll service. Friday from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m., Saturday from 7 a.m. (between midnight and 6 a.m. only small snacks) Sunday 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.

#### Free Bitburger at Finish

Free Bitburger 0.0% (alcohol-free) will be available. During the event, 0.0% products will be served in the Bitburger area (next to pit 33).

#### Lots

- > The lot size for a team of 4 is at least 40 m2. In most cases the dimensions are 12 x 3.5 m. Teams of 8 get two lots, teams of 2 and individual riders get half a lot each.
- The composition of the ground can be seen on the site plan (asphalt, gravel or grass).
- > Each lot has a number. The location is marked on the map. The entry zone can be seen from the color of the entry permit: blue and green over Dunlop bend. Yellow, orange and red over Hatzenbachtunnel.
- > Each lot is marked with a number. It hangs in the middle of the lot. The specified widths (usually 3.50 m) must be observed. "Border conflicts" are best solved bilaterally by the respective neighbors.
- In case of "neighborhood problems" keep calm and in case you don't find an amicable solution send the participants to the race office (next to pit 1).
- > Large advertising facilities are generally forbidden in the lot area.
- > Electricity is available in the vicinity of each lot. The participants must independently provide for plug connections and supply lines. The quantities of electricity are low and not designed for large gadgets such as refrigerators etc. this was communicated in advance!
- Having a barbecue is basically allowed with a suitable "device". The grill must always be supervised. Discharging barbecue charcoal for annealing is prohibited.

## Parking / Staying overnight

The parking lots A5, A6 and A7 are available for a one-time parking flat of 10€.

24-hour teams and individual riders received their entry permits in advance by post. Additional free parking lots are available in the Dunlop bend.

If you only want to pick up your participant documents on Friday, you may park free of charge from 4 p.m. on parking lot A8. Parking is free for one hour in the multilevel car park underneath the ring boulevard. Parking fees will then apply.




**Entry times:**
