ARTICLE 1. ORGANISATION

"Rad am Ring" and the Rad-Bundesliga race are organized by Eventwerkstatt GmbH, Eichendorffstraße 92, 71665 Vaihingen/Enz, Germany, phone +49 7042 2892211, fax +49 7042 2892219, www.radamring.de, according to the BDR regulations "Müller-Die lila Logistik-Rad-Bundesliga 2025" road men and the BDR general invitation to tender.

The race will take place on 20.07.2025.

The race will be held on the Nordschleife (5x 22km with 580 meters of altitude each lap) of the Nürburgring over a distance of approximately 110km.

Start: 13:00, Nürburgring, exit pit lane Grand Prix circuit.

Finish: around 16:00, Nürburgring, finish straight Grand Prix circuit.

ARTICLE 2. NATURE OF THE RACE

The race is part of the BDR calendar and part of the Rad-Bundesliga men. Participant admission regulations can be found in the general-announcement Rad-Bundesliga (GA-BL) men 2025.

ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPANTS

The admission of the participants will be made according to the general announcement Rad-Bundesliga (GA-BL) men 2025.

ARTICLE 4. RACE OFFICE / PERMANENCE / DOPING ROOM

The Permanence is located in the Start & Finish House (TÜV- Tower, 1st floor) in the Drivers Briefing Room (Tel. +49 157/50726390) and will be open from 08:30 on 20.07.2025.

Due to the ongoing 24h Rad am Ring event, there are no parking spaces available in front of the Permanence. We kindly ask you to make your way from the team parking lot P10 by bike.

Team leaders can confirm their starters there on 20.07.2025 from 09:00 to 10:45 (The back numbers of the Rad-Bundesliga will be used).

The **team leader meeting** will take place in the presence of the College of Commissioners on the same day at 11:00 am in the Start & Finish House in the Drivers Briefing Room (Tel. +49 157/50726390).

The **Race Office/Organization Office** (Tel. +49 157/50726390) is located on the first floor of the Pit Building next to Pit 1 and the Press Center is also located in the Start & Finish House in the Photographers Workroom.

The anti-doping test room after the race (20.07.2025) is located in the Medical Center diagonally opposite Box 33 in the paddock.

ARTICLE 5. RADIO TOUR

For radio-tour, as in previous years, digital radio equipment will be used and then issued.

ARTICLE 6. NEUTRAL MATERIAL SUPPLY

According to the Bundesliga General Tender the neutral material supply is organized by the Bundesliga.

ARTICLE 7. GRACE PERIODS

The race organizers may withdraw riders who are more than 15 minutes behind the main field.

ARTICLE 8. SPECIAL CLASSIFICATION

The following special classification will be held:

Sprint classifications at km:

- 63,1 1st finish passage
- 85,9 2nd finish passage
- 107,9 3rd finish passage/finish line

The first 3 riders of each stage will receive 3-2-1 points for the overall sprint classification. The winner of the sprint classification is the rider with the most points. If there is a tie, the number of classification wins will decide, then the number of second places and if applicable, the number of third places. If there is still a tie, the better placing in the finish will decide.
the winner will receive a cash prize of 200,00 €.

Mountain classifications at km:

- 54,6 Hohe Acht (max. 17%!)
- 77 Hohe Acht (max. 17%!)
- 99,4 Hohe Acht (max. 17%!)

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The first 3 riders of each stage will receive 3-2-1 points for the overall mountain classification. The winner of the mountain classification is the driver with the most points. In case of a tie, the number of classification wins will decide, then the number of second places and if applicable, the number of third places. If there is still a tie, the better placing in the finish will decide.
the winner will receive a cash prize of 200,00 €.

ARTICLE 9. PRIZE MONEY

The prize money will be paid according to the specifications of the Rad-Bundesliga Men 2025. The prize money will be paid in cash during the opening hours of the Participant Center Box 18 - 23 on the day of the event.

ARTICLE 10. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The regulations of the organization conducting the AD control (UCI or WADA/NADA) will be applied. The control will take place in the Medical Center diagonally opposite to Box 33 in the paddock.

ARTICLE 11. AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremonies will take place in accordance with the GA BL.

ARTICLE 12. CATALOGUE OF PENALTIES

The BDR penalty catalog is valid.

ARTICLE 13. MISCELLANEOUS

The washing of vehicles and bicycles with washing additives/cold cleaning agents is forbidden for reasons of environmental protection. If necessary, the organizer will designate washing parks that comply with the legal regulations.

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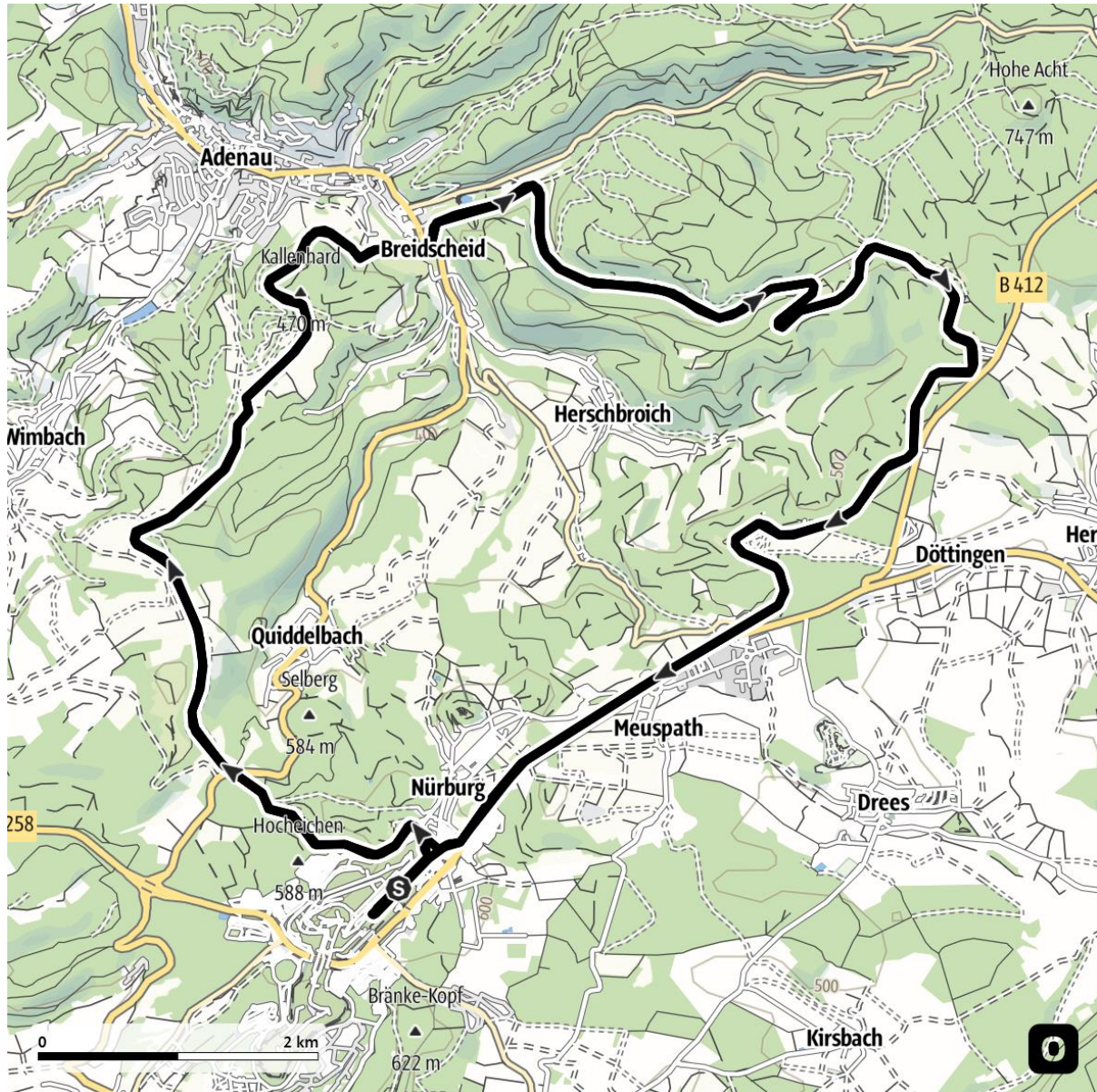
